Dear Parents/carers,

A warm welcome back to all of you and your children.

I will be here as Interim Executive Head Teacher this term, until a new permanent Head Teacher is employed. I have many years' experience as a Head Teacher in Suffolk, and recently moved to Norfolk. I am delighted to be working in the Flourish Federation, in such well-resourced schools with very strong staff teams. I have already met many children today and look forward to getting to know them and you, the parents this term.

Mrs Carol Jeary has agreed to return to work for a day and a half as Acting Deputy Head Teacher. She will be in school every Tuesday and I will be in the other 4 days. For the next 2 weeks, we will be in both schools each day. Monday, Wednesday and Friday am in Stibbard and Tuesday and Thursday am in North Elmham. We will move school in the afternoons, in order to be available to all parents each day.

Welcome to Mr Chester, Y5/6 teacher at North Elmham. There are no other changes of staff.

We have been busy reviewing and clarifying behavior sanctions and rewards, to ensure consistency for all. We are sharing these with pupils and will share the reviewed policy with parents once completed.

Pupils may wear PE kits, black shorts and white t-shirt, on their allocated PE days. You will be notified by class teachers this week, with curriculum information. They will also need a school jumper or plain navy or black sweatshirt as the weather gets cooler. In addition, they need to have trousers and a jacket for Wellie days.

Teachers will write to you later this week with Curriculum maps and more details.

I am completing a new Covid risk assessment. It remains much the same, but pupils should still attend school even if a parent or sibling contracts Covid. They should be tested (PCR Test) and continue to attend if they are negative but MUST NOT attend if they display any symptoms.
